Stay safe this Christmas, can you tick every item on this checklist?

1. Christmas lights have an Australian Approval number; Q12345, V01294, or N12345?
2. Safety switches on all circuits in your home
3. Outside lights designed for external use
4. Lights are extra low voltage
5. Outdoor connections are weatherproofed
6. No double adapters on power boards
7. Lights are clear of powerlines, swimming pools & driveways
8. Working smoke detectors
9. Lights and cables are free from damage
10. Lights are secured and out of a child's reach

If you cannot tick all of the above, call a Master Electrician today. Keep your loved ones safe this Christmas.

Tips

- Visit recalls.gov.au to check for any recalled Christmas lights
- Do not run 240-volt cabling to outside garden beds and lighting
- Always turn off outdoor lights during rain or storms
- Go solar if you can, it's better for the environment, and safer for you
- Check your safety switches work, push the test button and watch the lights go out.
